1.President's welcome

Dr. Marotta welcomes all Delegates also on behalf of Sabatino Aracu, FIRS President. He thanks the President of the Colombian Federation, Mr. Alberto Herrera Ayala ,Mr. Jorge Roldan, Mr. José Acevedo, the Colombian Authorities and all Collaborators/Volunteers, for having organised in short time these 2010 World Speed Skating Championships.

2. Minutes of the previous Assembly.

The Minutes of the previous Assembly of Gijon (Spain) 2008 are unanimously approved.

3. President's report.

"Dear Friends,

I have pleasure in summarising you with this report the intense activity carried out in the last two years together with the Colleagues of the Committee.

First of all, I am thanking the Colleagues Susan Currell, Ricardo Grin, Richard Hawkins, Kim Sang-Hun and especially my Vice President Carmelo Paniagua and the Secretary General Cecilia Nadin who intensively collaborated with me.

I remind you the marvellous 2008 edition of the Worlds in Gijon/Spain where 57 nations attended by marking our historical record with more than 500 participating skaters. There was a good reason for such a massive participation. In fact, two IOC Representatives were with us in those days observing the quality of our races, the standard of the organisation, the observance of IOC rules and above all anti doping rules.

Christophe Dubi, IOC Sports Director and his assistant Pierre Ducrey truly appreciated the qualities of our skaters and the excitement of races.

I want to thank once more the Royal Spanish Roller Federation for the perfect organisation of the Championships and for the warm welcome offered to IOC Delegates.

As you know the International Olympic Committee invited FIRS to fill a complicated questionnaire through which they totally analysed all the aspects of our discipline and of Roller Sports in general.

I may say you that the agonistic level of our sport was highly recognised, I cannot tell you the same as concerns the diffusion among media and television networks and above all the appeal to sponsors.

With a big economic effort and big investment in time, FIRS made a professional video to be shown at IOC Board on June 2009.

Most of you saw this promotional video and enjoyed it for sure.

I am seizing this opportunity for thanking Derek Parra and Ippolito Sanfratello for the collaboration offered us in making this video.

We presented our video to the IOC Board in Lausanne in June 2009 with the interventions of FIRS President, Sabatino Aracu, and I as FIRS Secretary General.

We received appreciations and congratulations for the quality of our presentation as well as for the high athletic standard of our sports discipline.

The IOC Board met on August 2009 and decided to include Rugby 7 and Golf in the Program of 2016 Olympic Games.

Dear Friends, I cannot conceal you the feeling of frustration at that news.

Lost time, wasted money but above all the lack of recognition for the quality of our skaters and their sacrifices that strongly put to the test our confidence about the objectiveness of the IOC Board members.

The IOC Congress- Copenhagen October 2009- ratified the choice of the Board. Rugby 7 and Golf became Olympic Sports. Money won.

Well, the diffusion of our disciplines among youth of all the continents should have deserved more consideration also thinking about the young enthusiasm that we were able to assure to the Olympic Movement. We lost a battle but not the war. We shall continue fighting, aware of our power, trying to grow looking for a higher appeal with media and sponsors.

Unfortunately the world financial crisis hit our sport too.

The Swiss Federation -to which the organisation of the 2009 World Championships was assigned-gave up in December 2008 and CIC had to look for another nation willing to organise the event, In few months the friends of Chinese Association accepted our invitation and they organised the 2009 Worlds in Haining City with a marvellous indoor track as well as the road circuit, above all that for marathon.

Our deep thanking for the organising efforts made in few months to the Friends of the Chinese Association, Mrs Lin Jie, Mr. Huang Qiang and the Haining's Organisers.

Unfortunately what happened in 2009 was repeated in 2010 too.

You will all remember the good presentation of the 2010 Worlds by Venezuela's friends in Haining City with the attendance of the Governor of Lara Department.

Domestic political problems obliged Venezuela's Federation to communicate us last February their impossibility in that commitment.

Once again, CIC was obliged to look for another country available in organising the event in few months. We wanted to stay in South America and we keep this commitment thanks to the extraordinary availability of the Colombian Federation and of its President, Mr. Alberto Herrera Ayala.

In few months and overcoming every type of difficulties, the Colombian friends have been able to organise the championships that will make Guarne the world capital of roller speed skating in the next days. Thank you Alberto, Thanks to your Collaborators. Thanks to Colombian Federation. Thanks to the Authorities of Guarne that made possible the organisation of a so big event.

Thank you to all attending Federations that honour the efforts of the Colombian Friends.

Colombia- world champion of our discipline- was able in making roller speed skating one of the most loved sports in that marvellous country.

The whole world family of roller speed skating will offer Guarne and to all Colombia, I am sure, an extraordinary sports show.

Korea's Federation has submitted request for organising our 2011 Worlds. I hope that everything may be smooth by knowing the extraordinary organising skills of Korean Friends, witnessed by the marvellous souvenir of our 2006 Worlds in Anyang City.

The Italian Federation has just confirmed its candidature for the year 2012, while the CIC is still examining the proposals received for 2013.

Dear Friends, roller speed skating is growing every year even more and it represents today the biggest disciplines of Roller Sports. We continue to work with guts and determination, we work with media and we increase the consideration that sports world has about us.

Before ending, I should like to give you some recommendations: do not forget the new disciplines that FIRS put under CIC control: inline downhill, freestyle skating, skateboarding and inline alpine slalom.

And now, let us dive in our 2010 World Championships.

Thank you Colombia. Thank you Guarne, we shall honour your efforts.

Report of President Dr. Roberto Marotta at the Elective Assembly of the Comité International de Course Ascoli Piceno (Italy) - September 7, 2012.

Dear Friends,

at the end of an intense four-year period of activity I am submitting you the report on what the CIC did for our loved discipline of roller speed skating.

After the marvellous 2008 edition in Pamplona/Spain, our worlds were regularly run every year; in 2009 in Haining City (China), in 2010 in Guarne (Colombia) and in 2011 in Yeosu (Korea) and today we are here in Italy for the 2012 Worlds.

A special thanking to the National Federations of the mentioned countries that, with commitment and collaborative feeling, ensured the success of our events allowing an important increase in the number of participating countries, today more than 60.

Our championships are held yearly since several years thanks to my personal constant care and that of the CIC Members in looking for organising nations, giving special attention to the continental turn over.

Thus, I thank all the friends of the Committee with whom I closely collaborated in those four years: the Vice President Carmelo Paniagua, Susan Currell, Kim Sang-Hun, Ricardo Grin and Richard Hawkins as well as our Secretary MariaCecilia Nadin.

Another special thanking to Dr. Patricia Wallace who accepted the important task of being the President of FIRS Anti Doping Commission. Then, I must thank the Italian Federation and its President Sabatino

Aracu for their constant logistics support and of human resources to our Committee.

Thanks too the Organising Committee of these Worlds scheduled in the two venues of Ascoli Piceno and San Benedetto del Tronto and its President, Romolo Bugari, that have been able to overcome, with the final contribution of the Italian Federations and of its President Sabatino Aracu too, the serious economic difficulties that jeopardized these events.

Thus, I am announcing you that the 2013 Worlds are scheduled in Belgium, in the marvellous city of Oostende where the new standard FIRS/CIC track has been inaugurated some days ago. The Belgian friends will inform you in a while about the program of the next year. In 2014 instead, we shall come back to Argentina again. Friends Marcelo Martinez, President of Argentina's Federation and Ricardo Grin, my CIC colleague from many years, promised a perfect organization of this event.

After a complicated work of revision made by the CIC in 2011, new rules were written down without changing the contents of the previous edition but organising articles of our technical rules in a better way. I must thank the French friend Hervé Lallement for his positive collaboration in such work.

The World Games were held in Kaohsiung (Chinese Taipei) in 2009 with success for roller speed skating. With my personal convincing plea to IWGA, I was successful in increasing the number of admitted skaters at the 2009 edition to 30 men and 30 ladies, giving a chance of participation to developing countries.

Thanks to the commitment of the friends of the Colombian Federation I obtained the admission of 35 men and 35 ladies at the 2013 World Games scheduled in Cali, Colombia. Furthermore, as invitation sport, for the first time in the history of the Worlds Games the roller speed skating competitions will be run on track and on the road with 5 + 5 skaters plus on the road.

Dear Friends, believe me, these results are not easy because IWGA is not willing to concentrate many medals in a sole sport.

Nevertheless, the show offered by our competitions allowed me in convincing IWGA Board about the increase of admitted skaters and the inclusion of competitions on the road.



The 2012 Worlds will be the basis for the selection to the admission at the 2012 World Games. Taken into account the high number of admitted skaters this will be a big opportunity for small federations too in obtaining the admission of some skaters. I remind you that Organisers will be responsible for free board and lodging at the WG.

And now, let us deal about the Olympic matter that we are taking care of.

In 2009, the IOC selected two new sports for the Olympic Program of Rio 2016: "Golf" and "Rugby 7". Notwithstanding our efforts and the marvellous and professional video prepared by FIRS and the attendance of our champions Derek Parra and Ippolito Sanfratello, the IOC Executive Board privileged two sports capable to give them economical benefits. Baseball, Softball, Karate and Squash out together with Roller Speed Skating.

We lost a battle but we are still fighting to achieve this big dream. As recognition of the IOC appreciation towards our discipline and the commitment and dedication of Sabatino Aracu and me, the IOC included again roller speed skating in the new short list of sports that could become Olympic ones. The selection will be done next year at the IOC Session in Buenos Aires.

As concerns our work of lobbying to reach the Olympic goal, I must underline the dreadful taste of some commentaries of those days about our incompetence in achieving this goal. Commentaries made by who, having FIRS responsibilities in past time was even unable to be recognised by IOC men as representative of our sport and being retired since long time, with acrimony, is trying to discredit our work.

What we need is a work of group involving all the presidents of the national federations who must get in touch with IOC Members of their own countries. Criticism is easy but each of us must positively work to create a total consensus towards our sport from the IOC Board being the sole key for a possible success.

I am announcing you that an IOC Member of the Commission for the Program, a Member of the Administrative Staff and the Vice Director of the IOC Sports Department will assist in the next days at our championships for a total evaluation of our discipline to give an exhaustive report to the Commission for the Program.



I remind all of you that the IOC recognizes FIRS as the sole governing body for all "Roller Sports". Thus, I invite all of you to insert in your national federations, under speed sector, the new disciplines: Downhill, Freestyle skating, Skateboarding, Alpine Slalom and Roller Derby.

In conclusion, let us go to the point, with your agreement we shall continue to work to achieve this goal that, if achieved or not achieved, will be an incentive to let grow our discipline and to increase the number of practicing countries in all the continents.

Dear Friends, by ending my report, I ask you to renew your confidence in me to allow me to go on with started programs for the development of roller speed skating in all the countries of the worlds.



PART "C" TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Chapter A - Competitions in general

Art. 1

Only CIC, Continental Confederations, National Confederations, and Federations, Associations and Clubs associated with these can organise official international competitions. No Federation or Club, which in some way is part of the FIRS structure, may participate in any privately organised international event, or in any event organised by groups not belonging to FIRS.

Art. 2

National a nd Continental Championships, competitions, criteria and any event organised within the recognised Continental Confederation, in which only members of those organisations can participate, do not need CIC approval.

Art. 3

National Federations and Continental Confederations shall send to the C.I.C.:

- a) the list of results;
- b) a written report about National and Con tinental Championships organised by them, immediately after the end of the competition.


Art. 4

Races on ro ad or track can be organised by all the different National F ederations and Confederations, for all the recognised categories.

Art. 5

World Championships will be held every two (even) years, National and Continental Championships of the same sport discipline can be organis ed only once a year. The winners of each competition are the official holders of the title until the following competition of the same kind.

2) There will be no loser's finals at the World Championship. Skaters not competing in the finals will be ranked with 1 (one) point.

Art. 19

The organising Federation shall meet the following expenses:

- organising fee for the World Senior Ch ampionships amounting to 45.000 U.S. dollars paid in advances to CIC. The same fee of 45.000 US \$ will be paid if World Junior and Senior Championships are organized together;
- organising fee for the World Junior Championships am ounting to 45.000 US \$ if organised separately from the Seniores.
- payment of travel, board and lodging expenses for the President, the Secretary and five (5) CIC members;
- payment of board and lodging expenses for FIRS Officials, up to a maximum of three (3) one of which could be the Representative of FIRS Medical Commission;
- payment of board and lodging expenses for the 8 international judges appointed by the CIC:
- -local transportation for CIC Members and International Judges appointed by the CIC;
- payment of board and lodging expenses for other International/National Judges of the organizing country, appointed if necessary in agreement with the Organizing Federation.

For all, board and lodging expenses will be met from the dinner of the second day preceding the beginning of the Championship, until the breakfast of the day after the end of the Championship.

- -* The organising Federation must broadcast—the event and—it must provide the TV signal in EBU quality standard for all the final events of the Championships to FIRS; that is the owner of international TV rights, at no charge. Furthermore, the organising federation must provide 5 copies of DVDs containing all TV coverages of all finals in EBU quality standard to CIC, at the end of the championship.
- FIRS is the owner of the TV-rights (see FIRS Bylaws "FIRS World Championships Regulations)
- Purchase of the jerseys of World Seni or Champion for each scheduled competition. The jersey of World Champion is reserved to senior category only.
- Reimbursement to CIC of the cost of the medals for the first three placed athletes in each competition.
- The organising Federation must provide and pay for the anti doping controls. A minimum of all winners and one random for each event must be tested.
- Organisers must send to FIRS the official results of anti-doping-control within and not later than one month from the end of the Championship.
- Organisers must let at CIC/FIRS disposal a banner of 20 m etres x 1m near the finish line on track and road for the promotion of its institutional image.
